Divisions (all ages as of January 1st)

- A. Beginners**– Open to riders age 12 and under. Entries will walk and trot/jog.
- B. Novice**- Open to riders 13 through adult. Entries will walk and trot/jog.
- C. Green Horses** – Open to riders with inexperienced or young horses. Riders must be at least 13 years old. Entries will walk and trot/jog.
- D. Juniors** – Riders 13 years and under. Entries will walk, trot/jog and canter/lope.
- E. Seniors** – Riders age 14 through 18. Entries will walk, trot/jog and canter/lope.
- F. Adult** – Riders age 19 and over. Entries will walk, trot/jog and canter/lope.

General Rules

1. This show is run following the Guidelines for Vermont 4-H and local Horse shows.
2. All riders 18 and under must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet while mounted on the show grounds.
3. The judge's decision is final.
4. Any class may be combined or canceled if fewer than three entries.
5. No alcoholic beverages on the grounds.
6. Stallions over one year of age must be handled by a handler that is 19 or older.
7. All dogs must be on a leash. Please consider leaving dogs at home.
8. Chaps are not allowed in equitation classes.
9. No tie downs, drop nose bands or hackamores except for the gymkhana section of the horse show.
10. Refunds will be given only in the case of illness/injury/accident of rider or horse. A Vet or Physicians note is required.
11. Current Negative Coggins and Rabies certificate must be shown for entry to grounds. Please mail a copy in with your entry.
12. Each horse and rider is considered a riding unit and must obtain a number.
13. Show management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show and combine or cancel classes.
14. Any horse/rider combination that enters any Beginner, Novice or Green Horse class cannot show in any class with cantering/loping at the show (games included).

13. **Dressage Suitability** (English or Western. Entries will walk, trot or jog, canter or lope, and may be asked for extended trot.)
14. **Hunter Hack** (Entries will walk, trot, canter and jump 2 fences.)
15. **Western Reining**
16. **Versatility** (Each entry to ride English, change tack and ride Western.)
17. **Stick Horse** (6 and under). Bring your favorite stick horse and show your stuff!
